## Upward Bound Summer Food Service Program News Release Enrolled Sites and Camps

The EKU Upward Bound Program is participating in the Summer Food Service Program (SFSP). Upward Bound has applied to the SFSP as a residential camp and is considered a closed site. Meals will be provided free of charge to all eligible **Upward Bound Students** attending 2017 Chautauqua Summer Program. (To be eligible to receive free meals at a residential or non-residential camp, children must meet the income guidelines for reduced-price meals in the National School Lunch Program. The income guidelines for reduced-price meals by family size are listed on the next page.) Children who are part of households that receive Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP, formerly foods stamps) benefits or benefits under the Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR), or Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF) are automatically eligible to receive free meals.

Acceptance and participation requirements for the Program and all activities are the same for all regardless of race, color, national origin, sex, age or disability, and there will be no discrimination in the course of the meal service. Meals will be provided at the EKU Powell Building at 521 Lancaster Ave., 17 Powell, Richmond KY 40475.
